

CONSTITUTION OF THE
GODDARD RETIREES AND ALUMNI ASSOCIATION (GRAA)

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this organization is the Goddard Retirees and Alumni Association, herein referred to as GRAA.

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

To afford all members a medium for continuing association and communication through monthly luncheons, social events, travel, and volunteer work for various Goddard Space Flight Center (GSFC) functions. All members are provided with the GRAA Membership Directory and a periodic GRAA Newsletter.

ARTICLE III: ORGANIZATION

GRAA is organized and re-organized under the By-Laws of the Goddard Employees Welfare Association (GEWA).

ARTICLE IV: ADMINISTRATION


GRAA shall be administered by a Board of Directors of seven GRAA members elected by the membership. The Board of Directors shall elect the Director of the Board, a Vice President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer. The Director of the Board shall serve as the President of GRAA.

ARTICLE V: MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to all retired GSFC civil service employees and alumni. An alumnus is a person who ever worked as a civil service employee at the Goddard Space Flight Center and had retired from elsewhere. A member's spouse and other persons may participate in GRAA activities as guests but shall have no vote in the establishment of GRAA policies or decisions and may not hold an office.

ARTICLE VI: AMENDMENTS

Any member may petition to have the Constitution or the By-Laws amended. Proposed amendments must be submitted in writing to the GRAA Board of Directors and must be approved by two-thirds of all members present at any scheduled meeting.
